To: Interested Parties former Hakalau pesticide mixing site,

It has been some time now since the HEER Office conducted a public meeting on a proposed cleanup plan for the former Hakalau pesticide mixing site, and a final decision has been delayed due to an issue that came up after the public meeting. Consequently, wanted to provide an update on the site to those who had expressed interest by coming to the public meeting or sending in comments. Please see the attached letter which describes comment on proposed cleanup alternatives from the public meeting, how the HEER Office was thinking to address those comments, the cliff stability issues that came up after the public meeting, and our recent request of the landowner for further analysis of alternative cleanup options in light of this issue. As further information and alternatives analysis is available, I will provide updates to you, and make a decision whether an additional public meeting may be appropriate before a final determination is made for the site.
