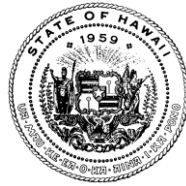

The Hawaii Department of Health (HDOH), Hazard Evaluation and Emergency Response (HEER) Office has reviewed the Phase II Environmental Site Assessment Report referenced above. The HEER Office concurs with the conclusions that new Reservoirs A and B stockpiled soil may be used to rebuild the reservoir embankments and that it can be assumed that contaminant of potential concern concentrations in the Reservoirs A and B soil stockpiles do not exceed Tier 1 Environmental Action Levels based on the representative sampling that was conducted.
