CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS:

Effective March 9, 2012, the parties mutually agree that the CONTRACTOR shall continue to provide the required services with the following modifications:

- 1. Attachment-S5, Special Conditions.
 - a. Paragraph 5. on Page 1 is hereby modified to read as follows:
 - "5. Campaign Contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body."
 - b. In accordance with paragraph 7. on Page 2, the time of performance is extended from May 12, 2012, to and including December 31, 2012, to include an additional summer harvest season and further best management practices installation.
 - c. Paragraph 9. on Page 2 is hereby modified to read as follows:
 - "9. <u>Insurance</u>. The CONTRACTOR shall obtain, maintain, and keep in force throughout the period of this Contract, the following types of insurance:
 - A. General liability insurance issued by an insurance company in the amount of at least ONE MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) for bodily injury and property damage liability arising out of each occurrence and TWO MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$2,000,000.00) aggregate.
 - B. Automobile insurance issued by an insurance company in an amount of at least ONE MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence.

The insurance shall be obtained from a company authorized by the law to issue such insurance in the State of Hawaii (or meet Section 431: 8-301, Hawaii Revised Statutes, if utilizing an insurance company not licensed by the State of Hawaii).

For both the general liability and automobile liability insurance, the insurance coverage shall be primary and shall cover the insured for all work to be performed under the Contract, including changes, and all work performed incidental thereto or directly or indirectly connected therewith. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain in effect this liability insurance until the STATE certifies that the CONTRACTOR's work under the Contract has been completed satisfactorily.

Prior to or upon execution of this Contract, the CONTRACTOR shall obtain a certificate of insurance verifying the existence of the necessary insurance coverage in the amounts stated above. The parties agree that the certificate of insurance shall be attached hereto as Exhibit "K" and made a part of this Contract.

Each insurance policy required by this Contract shall contain the following clauses:

- (1) The State of Hawaii and its officers and employees are additional insured with respect to operations performed for the State of Hawaii.
- (2) It is agreed that any insurance maintained by the State of Hawaii will apply in excess of, and not contribute with, insurance provided by this policy.

The certificate of insurance shall indicate these provisions are included in the policy.

The CONTRACTOR shall immediately provide written notice to the contracting department or agency should any of the insurance policies evidenced on its certificate of insurance forms be cancelled, limited in scope, or not renewed up expiration.

If the scheduled expiration date of the insurance policy is earlier than the expiration date of the time of performance under this Contract, the CONTRACTOR, upon renewal of the policy, shall promptly cause to be provided to the STATE an updated certificate of insurance."

- 2. The "Project Timeline," attached to the Contract as Exhibit "B," is hereby deleted and replaced with a revised "Project Timeline," attached hereto as Exhibit "L" and made a part hereof.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain the same.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE
